

Pakchong School Announces No. 88/2024

Pakchong School is in need of qualified native English-speaking teachers to teach the English subject to Thai students at Pakchong School from secondary school levels M.1 to M.3. The teacher for this academic year will start school on May 1st, 2024.

- 1. Qualifications of foreign teacher to work at Pakchong School:
- 1.1 Native speakers from the United Kingdom, United States, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand will receive a salary of 45,000 baht.
- 1.2 Foreigners using English as a second language, including those from South Africa, Netherlands, Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Finland, Luxembourg, Austria, Germany, Poland, Ireland, and France, will start at a salary of 42,000 baht provided they meet the following criteria: Educated in an English-speaking country for at least one year or attained the English proficiency test with scores of TOEIC 850, IELTS 7.5 or TOEFL 590.
- 1.3 Non-native speakers will commence with a salary of 37,000 bath provided they meet the following criteria: Educated in an English-speaking country for at least one year or attained the English proficiency test with scores of TOEIC 850, IELTS 7.5 or TOEFL 590.
- 1.4 The school will not cover additional expenses specific to foreign teachers, including work permit fees, passport fees (visa), essential documents required by the school, as well as costs associated with life insurance and medical coverage.
 - 1.5 Male / Female age 23 55 years old
 - 1.6 Graduated in Bachelor's Degree or equivalent in a related field
- 1.7 Have a certificate of Thai Culture training course. / The teachers' Council of Thailand (Kurusapha)
 - 1.7 Teaching qualifications and experience are an advantage.
 - 1.8 Teaching duties for at least 18 hours per week.
 - 1.9 Be able to have a full-time job at school on 7.30 a.m. 5.30 p.m.
 - 1.10 Good character, interpersonal skills, and service-oriented mindset.

1.11 Availability to undertake additional tasks assigned by the school beyond teaching responsibilities.

2. Documents needed to apply

- 2.1 One photocopy of passport and last stamp or ID card.
- 2.2 One photocopy of Certificate of your degree and transcript of records
- 2.3 Two photographs (1.5 inches size) taken not later than six months
- 2.4 One photocopy of Teacher License
- 2.5 Other documents (i.e. Change of status, marriage contract)
- 2.6 The medical certificate has to be issued by a hospital or a qualified medical clinic in Thailand. It must be issued not more than 1 month before the application submission.

We offer a year contract. The successful candidate shall be responsible for visa, Medical certificate, teacher license and teaching experience.
